Conifers

As effectively the most representative of the gymnosperms, a group of plants with seeds but not flowers, through the fossil record it is known that conifers have existed for more than 280 million years. Their leaves are usually needle-shaped and persistent. They are woody plants that reproduce by means of seeds that contain thickenings and an embryo that grows until it becomes an adult plant.

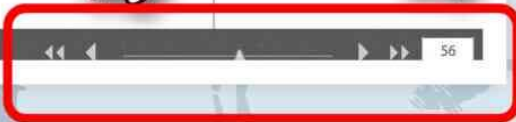
Wood from conifers is an important source of timber and is used in a wide range of products. It is also used in the production of paper and other products. The wood is known for its durability and resistance to decay.

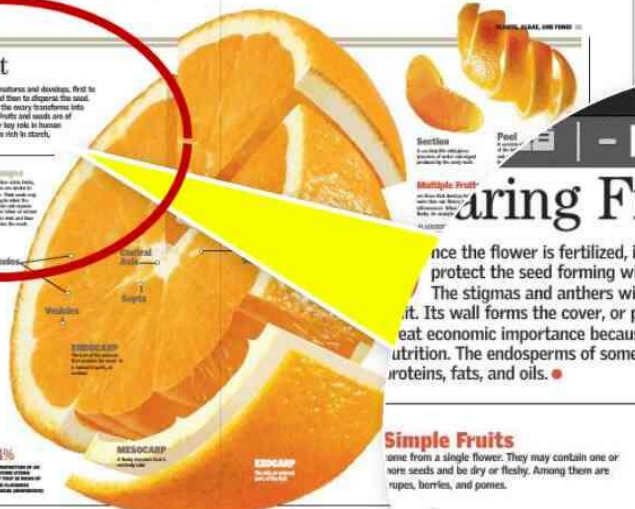
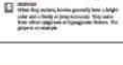

Bearing Fruit

Once the flower is fertilized, its ovary matures and develops, first to protect the seed forming within it and then to disperse the seed. The stigma and anthers wither, and the ovary transforms into fruit. Its wall forms the cover, or pericarp, and the seeds are of great economic importance because of their key role in human nutrition. The endosperms of some seeds are rich in starch, proteins, fats, and oils.

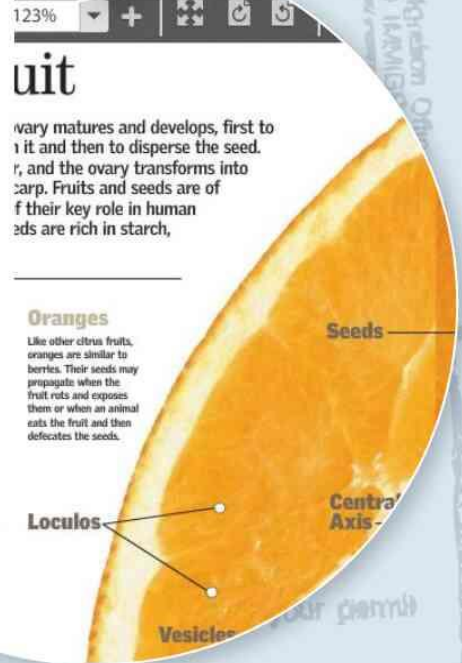

Simple Fruits

Some fruits come from a single flower. They may contain one or more seeds and be dry or fleshy. Among them are raspberries, strawberries, and pineapples.

Oranges

Like other citrus fruits, oranges are similar to lemons. Their seeds may propagate when the fruit rots and exposes them or when an animal eats the fruit and then defecates the seeds.

Loculus

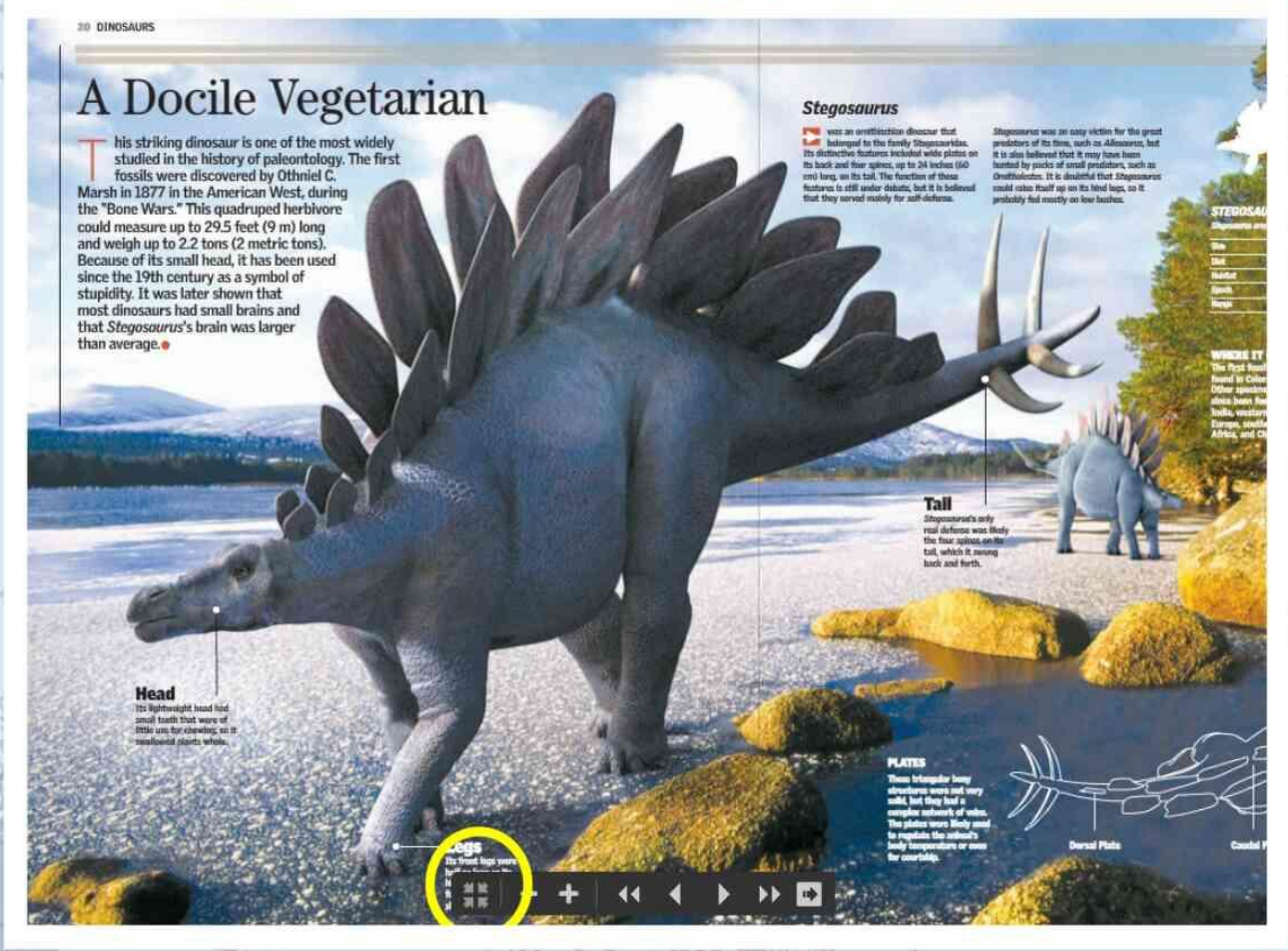
The loculus is the chamber in the ovary that contains the ovules. It is formed by the fusion of the ovary wall and the ovule. The loculus is the part of the ovary that is most important for the development of the fruit.

Diet of Fungi

TRANSFORMATION
Fungi are organisms that can transform dead organic matter into living biomass. Other organisms are parasites, in living hosts, or predators, which live off the top. Many others establish relationships of mutual benefit with algae, bacteria, or plants and other organisms.

PROCESSES
Fungi break down complex molecules into simpler ones, making them available for use by other organisms.

DECOMPOSITION
Fungi break down dead organic matter into simpler molecules, making them available for use by other organisms.

SYMBIOSIS
Fungi form symbiotic relationships with other organisms, such as plants and animals.

REGULATION
Fungi help regulate the population of other organisms in an ecosystem.

DIET
Fungi feed on a wide variety of organic matter, including plants, animals, and other fungi.

SPERMATOPHYTES
These are a group of plants that have adapted to life on land.

GROWTH
Fungi grow by extending their hyphae into new areas of their environment.

DIFFERENTIATION
Fungi can differentiate into different forms, such as mushrooms, molds, and yeasts.

REPRODUCTION
Fungi reproduce by producing spores that can be dispersed by wind or water.

ADAPTATION
Fungi have adapted to a wide variety of environments, from deserts to rainforests.

EVOLUTION
Fungi have evolved over time, developing new adaptations to their environment.

CELLS
Fungal cells are made of chitin, a tough polysaccharide.

MYCELIUM
The body of a fungus is made of a network of hyphae called mycelium.

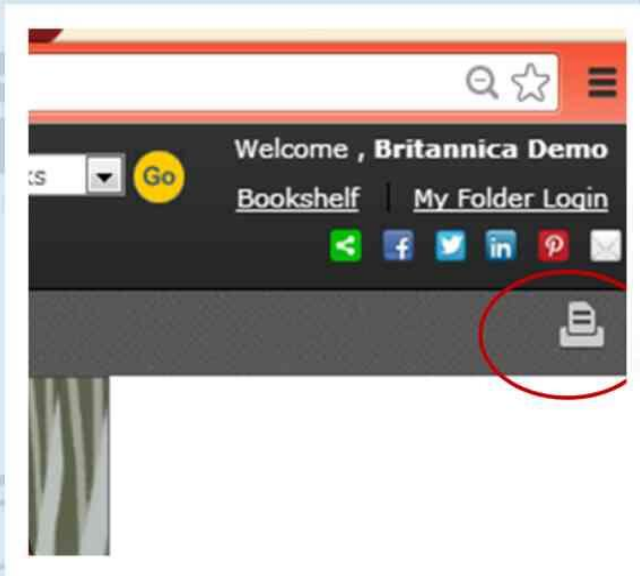
