 - A new pattern of examination was introduced in the month of January, 2021 to discourage rote learning and to lay emphasis on conceptual clarity, same will be followed in Annual Examination. Kindly note the important information regarding the examination and ensure strict follow up.
 - Total weightage of marks for each subject is 50. The exam for Social Science (Class III-IV) and Hindi will be in two parts - **Subjective and Objective** and for English, Maths and Science are of paper I and paper II.
 - The weightage of Subjective paper is 30 marks and the weightage of Objective paper is 20 marks. For English, Maths and Science – Paper I and Paper –II of 25 marks each.

- Total weightage of marks for each subject is 100. The exam for Social Science, Hindi and Sanskrit will be in two parts - **Subjective and Objective** and for English, Maths and Science are of paper I and paper II.
 - The weightage of Subjective paper is 60 marks and the weightage of Objective paper is 40 marks. For English, Maths and Science – Paper I and Paper –II of 50 marks each.
 - The combined assessment of both will be reduced to 80.
