The CBSE All India Class X and class XII Board Exam Results 2022-23 were very gratifying with **100%** pass percentage. The class XII QPI was **80.88%**. 79 students i.e. 22.63% of students secured 90% and above. **Swayam Arora** and **Sanya Khurana**, the science and commerce toppers secured **97.6%** and **98.8%** and the Humanities topper **Gauri Birla** secured **95.8%**. Swayam secured the highest PCM i.e. **98.67%** and highest PCC i.e. **98.4%**. The highest PCB of **96.33%** was secured by **Aditya Sharma** and **Vidhi Somani**. The vocational topper is **Yuvraj Narang** with **89.8%**. **Sanya Khurana, Swayam Arora** and **Rudra**

Gupta obtained 100 percent marks in Maths, **Sanya Khurana** and **Gunn Kalra** in Business Studies; and **Vaibhav Gupta** in Economics.

It is indeed a source of immense pride that our students are getting enrolled in reputed professional colleges and the colleges of Delhi University.

The class X CBSE Board Result has been equally stimulating. The QPI secured was **82.96%**. 74 students i.e. **23.19%** of students secured **90%** and above. **Ada Tandon** and **Avantika Srivastava** were the toppers with **98.2%** followed by **Vyomika, Sachin** and **Manisha** with **97.60%** and **Aanya Jain** with **97.4%**.
