Dear Parents

I feel proud to share with you that the school has capitalized on the full potential of online learning and emerged stronger from this global crisis than ever before. The ready support of parents and the zeal of our dear students has boosted our morale and the team efforts have paid rich dividends.

Here's a glance at the historic events organized, festivals celebrated and outstanding achievements in this period.

The class XII CBSE Board Results stands testimony to the quality education being provided in the school. I would like to share with you the highlights of the result. The **QPI** is an all time highest **84.14**. So are the stream aggregates that is Science - 99% secured by Vishu Gupta, Commerce - 98.8% - Arvind Sheshadri, Humanities - 94.4% - Tisha Dhall and Vocational stream - 95.20% - Vidhi Arora. Vishu Gupta has secured highest PCM i.e. 99.33%% and highest PCB i.e. 99%. 108 students i.e. 32.18% of students have secured 90% and above. 100 marks have been secured by Vaibhav Gupta, Ayush Srivastava & Vishu Gupta in Maths and by Ira Sharma in Music.

The class X CBSE Board Result has been equally stimulating. The **QPI** secured is **82.45** and 99 students i.e. 25.84% of students have secured 90% and above. The toppers are Swayam Arora with 99.20%, Gunn Kalra with 98.60% % and Sambhav Gupta with 98.60%. A brilliant 100 marks have been attained by 4 students in Maths, 3 students in Science, 5 students in Social Studies and 10 students in Artificial Intelligence.

Mrs. Gargi Chhabra, Supervisory Incharge, Primary and Cambridge Wings, has been selected to receive the coveted **Delhi State Award** for teachers for her outstanding contribution in the field of education. Her remarkable accomplishment is a feather in the school's cap.

The school organized its annual event online, **CROSSROADS 2021**, an array of Interschool Competitions. The event drew an overwhelming response and around 1200 students from 72 schools participated in the 15 subject related competitions.

It has also organized **Kreativ 2021**, online Interschool German Competitions, in collaboration with Goethe institute, Max Mueller Bhavan. Around 500 students from 79 schools from India and abroad participated in the grand event.

The annual extravaganza, **EXPO 2021**, for classes VII to X and the Cambridge Wing, conducted on a virtual platform, was a kaleidoscope of talent, creativity, innovation and knowledge.

The school welcomed its **new Chairman, Prof Ved Prakash** to the premises on the occasion of Abhinandan Samaroh. He inspired the 200 above staff with his illuminating address.

The **Arya Yuva Club, Health and Wellness Club, Finlit Club, Global Watch Club, Paryavision Club and Inquisitive Club** conducted the Induction Ceremony where the team of Council members pledged to help manifest the objective of the Club. Other Clubs are following the same. The **Artificial Intelligence Club** is playing a stellar role in promoting IT skills amongst students.

The school successfully organized celebration of Independence Day, Investiture Ceremony, DAVMUN, Praestantia, Cyber Week, Career Counseling sessions, Meet my Mentor activity, Yoga Divas, Rotary Installation Ceremony, Thalassaemia awareness talk, retirement Ceremonies besides a host of other activities. It has conducted unit tests, held PTM's, all on a digital platform.

Many students have got prestigious awards in prestigious competitions at school, state and national levels. I request you to browse through the school website **www.dldavpp.com** regularly for latest updates, news, achievements and school information.

The school has implemented NEP 2020 for its holistic and futuristic approach to education. As such experiential learning and development of all skills is an integral part of the teaching and learning process in school.

The school is conducting Practicals, project work, ASL activities at virtual platform so that students are empowered at all levels. It introduced the Oral Component Test to promote thoroughness in preparation and the Buddy Binding Bustle to promote companionship in class.

It is a matter of great gratification that the unprecedented lockdown of schools has not disrupted either the teaching or learning process or in any way posed a threat to any school activity. The contribution of all stakeholders- staff, parents and students is indeed appreciable and sets an inspiring example of teamwork and resilience. 
Please note that all important decisions related to school especially for students of classes X and XII are taken as per instructions from MHRD or CBSE. Kindly refer to the CBSE circular regarding conduct of offline examination for students of class XII. The decision stems out of the need for practice and preparation for Board Examination which hopefully may be conducted offline.

Kindly note the following points in regard to conduct of Term I offline Pre Board Exams for students of class XII —

1. Offline Pre-Board exams Term-1 will be conducted from **22 September to 5 October, 2021**.
2. Students will enter school from separate allotted gates. Entry in school will be from **8.00 a.m. to 8.50 a.m.** after which gates will be closed.
3. Thermal screening will be done at entry point.
4. Classrooms will be sanitized prior to student entry.
5. The new normal etiquettes of social distancing will be strictly observed.
6. All movement will take place under strict vigilance of teachers.
7. Students will be seated in small numbers in classes following all safely parameters.
8. The dispersal will take place in similar manner.
9. Students will be expected to strictly wear masks, carry sanitizers and personal stationery. No exchange or borrowing will be allowed. They will carry personal water bottles and refreshments.
10. Exam will be conducted from **9.00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.**
11. As per experience of last year CBSE gives weightage to offline exams only. The aim of the offline exam is to do away with offline exam phobia and allow students to evaluate their preparation and potential.
12. The offline Pre-Board, Term-I Exam will be 60 marks MCQ to cover wide areas. Another practice paper will be conducted as per situation.
13. The exam will be followed by offline classes for counseling, discussion on performance of exams, Practical/Project work. During offline classes no virtual classes will be conducted as per Govt. orders.
14. Transport facility will not be provided and students will commute by themselves.
15. Once outside school, counsel your ward to be careful about social distancing and not gather in groups anywhere.
16. Preparatory leave for the students of class XII will be from **18 to 21 September 2021**.
17. School Uniform and stationery is available in the canteen from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

I am sure that you understand that your ward's safety is equally our concern. So, is her/his performance in the Board Exams. I seek your cooperation in the smooth and successful conduct of the exams necessitated in the best interest of your ward. Please find attached the date-sheet for the 1st Pre Board Examination.
