The **class X and XII CBSE Board Results** stand testimony to the quality education provided in the school. The class XII QPI of students this year was 82.31% which is the highest so far.

74 students i.e. 27.30% of students secured 90% and above. 117 students i.e 43.17% of students secured distinctions in all five subjects. Mukund Maheshwari and Nidhi Jain, our science and commerce toppers secured 97.4% and 97.2% and our humanities topper Anjali Yadav secured 95.8%. Mukund and Varun secured highest PCM i.e. 98.3%. The highest PCC is 98.6% secured by Mukund. The highest PCB is 96.6% secured by Aastha Kesari. Our vocational topper is Srishti Chaudhary with 90%. 100 marks have been secured by Heena and Aastha in Biology, Mukund in Chemistry and Computer Science, Sanchita in Computer Science and Khushi in Economics. We can proudly boast of 100% placement of students in reputed colleges.

The class X CBSE Board Result has been equally stimulating. The QPI secured is 80.52%. 90 students i.e. 24.53% of students have secured 90% and above. 254 students i.e. 69.20% students have secured distinctions in all 5 subjects. Piya Arora is the topper with 97.4% followed by Ayush & Nehal with 97% and Vishu with 96.6.%. Maahir, Vishu, Himani and Mansi have attained 100 in Mathematics and Vaibhav, Ananya and Yashika have secured 100 in Social Studies.

Sumi Misra and Yajur Chhabra are among top 50 and will visit Kerala to witness the Solar Eclipse. 8 students have won reflector telescopes with solar filters.
- 2) Vaibhav Gupta secured International Rank 1 in NSO Exam. He has won cash prize of Rs. 50000/- and a gold medal. He has also won high distinction excellence award in the Australian National Chemistry Quiz. He was awarded cash prize of Rs. 1000/- for securing national rank 15 in NSTSE.
- 3) Ours is the only school in the country, to have two national winners in Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan. Priyal Jain stood 1st and Aditya stood 2nd out of 1.5 Lakh students, who participated in the national camp organized by Govt. of India and NCERT. Priyal & Aditya were awarded cash prizes of Rs. 25,000/- and Rs. 15000/-.
- 4) **Aarav Gupta** secured Rank II at national level in All India Astronomy Test and was awarded a cash prize of Rs. 50,000/- and a telescope in an award ceremony held in Dubai.

- 5) **Vaibhav Gupta** won Rank 2 and **Swayam Arora** won Rank 3 at national level in Globe Science and Environment Olympiad 2018.
- 6) **Priyal Jain, Vaibhav Gupta, Yash Garg, Harsh Giri & Tanisha Behera** have been selected for stage 2 examination in NTSE 2019.
- 7) **Jai Gandhi** secured 3rd position at national level Humming Bird Spell Bee Contest 2019.
- 8) **Sahil Srivastav** won 2nd position in Slogan Competition organized by Ministry of Environment and was awarded cash prize of Rs. 7000/-.
- 9) **Swapnil Mehta** has been selected as the Best Performer in national level Space Science Essay Writing Competition.
- 10) **Jatin** and **Shivank Kumar Gupta** have secured ranks 2 & 3 in ICT Olympiad Exams conducted by DAVCAE.
- 11) Gautam Gupta secured 3rd position for his project "Smart Gloves" in Innovation Fair organised at National Science Centre. Swasti Sharma also won 3rd prize for her model.
- 12) Naitik has won a laptop and Palak and Kashvi have won tablets in 'Yeh Diwali Alag Nirali contest' under the aegis of Lung Care Foundation.
